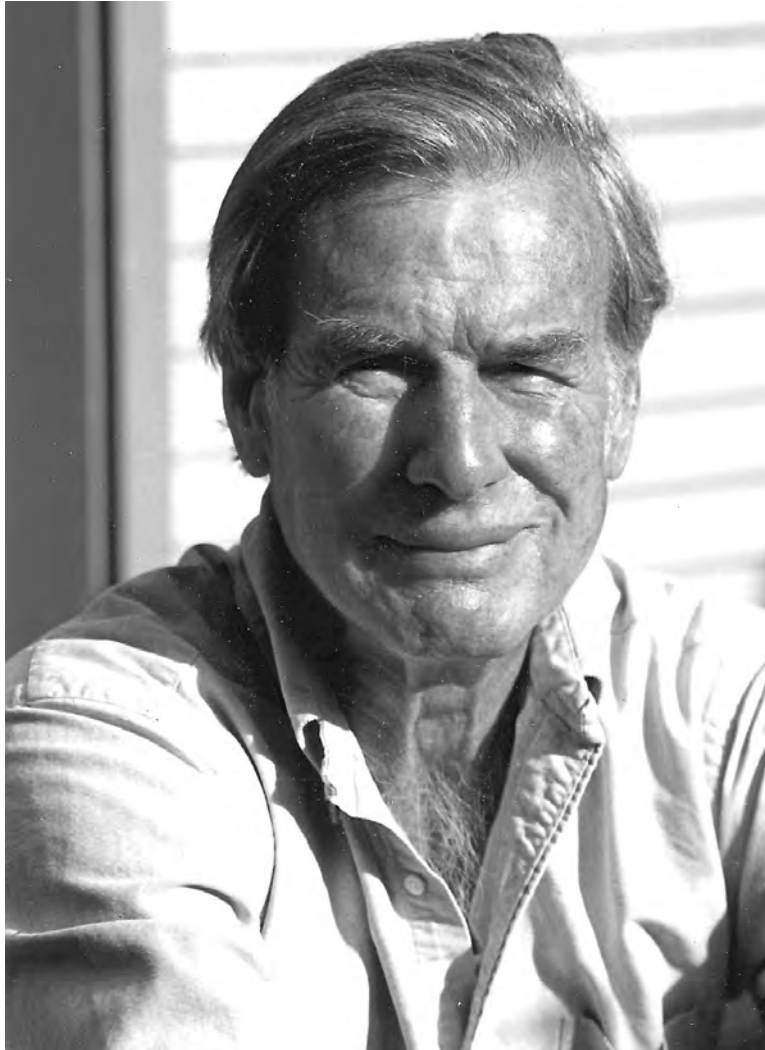

DEDICATION

**ARTHUR WILLIAMS (1926-2013)**

The Town of Fayston and its residents honor and celebrate the life of Arthur Williams who passed away on December 28, 2013. A long time resident of Fayston, Arthur moved here with his wife Hannah in 1958. Arthur was a devoted and generous contributor to the town, the Mad River Valley community and the State of Vermont. The list of his accomplishments and endeavors is truly remarkable. He served three terms as Fayston's Representative to the State Legislature; he served on Fayston's first Planning Commission and started the Mad River Valley Community Fund. He was an original investor in the Sugarbush Ski Resort, started the Friends of the Vermont State House, served as Executive Director of the Vermont Council on the Arts and he founded the Mad River Valley Polo Club. He was a tireless supporter of early childhood education. Toward the end of his life Arthur was an eloquent advocate for Death with Dignity legislation. However, he would frequently say about his many achievements: "none compare with the satisfaction of having a long and loving marriage to Hannah, our wonderful children, grandchildren and my friends." We are fortunate to have known such a kind and decent man.
